

St. Louis City Ordinance 63517

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [95] 71

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN DANIEL MCGUIRE

An ordinance making a supplemental appropriation for current expenses of the government for the fiscal year which began July 1, 1995 and ends June 30, 1996, amounting to the sum of Five Hundred Ten Thousand, One Hundred Three Dollars (\$510,103) from the Police Department Capital Improvements Account of the Capital Improvements Sales Tax Trust Fund No. 1220; and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, Section 6, Article XVI, of the City Charter, and Section 5.14.110 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, 1994, Annotated, authorize appropriations when any accruing, unappropriated City revenue is available and when the Board of Estimate and Apportionment recommends same; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment made a recommendation for expenditure of the above sum; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the Board of Aldermen in adopting Ordinance 62885 which created the Capital Improvement Sales Tax Trust Fund was, in part, to dedicate ten percent of said trust fund for the capital needs of the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department; and whereas, said ordinance restricted the use of said revenues credited to the Police Department Capital Improvements Account of said trust fund to the payment of bonded debt incurred before June 4, 1993 to the end that, if a fund balance remained in this account after the annual payment of said bonded debt, the Board of Police Commissioners could and should petition the Boards of Estimate and Apportionment, and Aldermen for an ordinance to appropriate any unappropriated revenue in said trust fund account on a detailed line item basis; and whereas the amount of Five Hundred Ten Thousand, One Hundred Three Dollars (\$510,103) is the unappropriated and unencumbered fund balance in the Police Department Capital Improvements Account for the fiscal year which ended June 30, 1994

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section Nine of Ordinance 62885, approved June 4, 1993, there is hereby appropriated and set apart the sum of Five Hundred Ten Thousand, One Hundred Three Dollars (\$510,103)

from revenues in the Police Department Capital Improvements Account of the Capital Improvements Sales Tax Trust Fund No. 1220 only for the purposes and in the amounts as detailed in Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance; provided, however, that the Comptroller may transfer up to ten percent of the money hereby appropriated from any one line item to any other line item with the approval of the Board of Police Commissioners and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, but neither the Comptroller nor the Board of Police Commissioners shall otherwise transfer, expend, use, or encumber any money hereby appropriated for any other purpose or to any other line item, sub-account, account or fund without the approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, and the Board of Aldermen by Resolution; and provided further, that all unexpended or unencumbered funds hereby appropriated shall revert to said Police Department Capital Improvements Account of the Capital Improvements Sales Tax Trust Fund, except as provided above in this section.

SECTION TWO. The Board of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to let contracts, employ and pay for labor, wages, consultants, employees, supervision and otherwise provide for designing, constructing, replacing, repairing, furnishing and equipping the construction work outlined in Section One.

SECTION THREE. The work provided for herein shall be carried out in accordance with detailed plans and specifications to be prepared by the Board of Public Service.

SECTION FOUR. If let by contract said contract, or contracts, shall provide that the contractor, or contractors, doing said work shall guarantee and keep in repair all of the work and materials used in connection therewith for a term of one year, commencing on the date of acceptance of the work by the City.

SECTION FIVE. All contractors awarded any contracts pursuant to this Ordinance shall meet the City's goals for minimum participation by MBE/WBE'S in the contracts and the reporting requirements adopted by the City for monitoring compliance with these goals.

SECTION SIX. The Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to disburse funds appropriated by Section One and is further authorized to receive and disburse funds in accordance with this Ordinance, upon certification of vouchers by the Board of Police Commissioners.

SECTION SEVEN. All construction contracts let under authority of this ordinance shall provide that no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages in the City of St. Louis, as determined by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri (Section 290.210 through 290.340 as amended RSMo 1989) for each craft or type of workmen needed in the actual work on the jobs herein authorized, as well as the general prevailing rate of pay for legal holidays and overtime work shall be paid to all workmen. All contracts let in connection with the work provided for herein shall be subject to, and in conformance with, all statutes of the State of Missouri and the Charter of the City of St. Louis.

SECTION EIGHT. This ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, safety, and morals, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to Article IV, Sections 19 and 20, of the Charter and shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
