

St. Louis City Ordinance 63671

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [95] 267

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN Joseph D. Roddy

An ordinance designating the intersection of TAYLOR AVENUE and DUNCAN AVENUE as a four-way stop intersection, and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, the intersection of TAYLOR AVENUE AND DUNCAN AVENUE is already a stop intersection regulating traffic on DUNCAN AVENUE; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to regulate traffic on TAYLOR AVENUE at DUNCAN AVENUE by installing stop signs on TAYLOR AVENUE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. TAYLOR AVENUE at its intersection with DUNCAN AVENUE is hereby designated as a stop intersection for the purpose of regulating traffic on both TAYLOR AVENUE AND DUNCAN AVENUE at said intersection.

SECTION TWO. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
