

St. Louis City Ordinance 63697

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [95] 359

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN DANIEL J. MCGUIRE

An ordinance, pertaining to the operation of motor vehicles, to be codified as Section 17.16.440 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, prohibiting the operation of a motor vehicle on any private lot, road, driveway, parking lot or any area which is not a roadway, for the purpose of avoiding travel upon the right of way between one highway or roadway and the same or another highway or roadway, or for the purpose of avoiding a lawfully erected barricade closing a highway or roadway; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. 17.16.440. Shortcutting Traffic Prohibited. No driver shall operate a motor vehicle on any private lot, road, driveway, parking lot or any area which is not a roadway, for the purpose of avoiding travel upon the right-of-way between one highway or roadway and the same or another highway or roadway, or for the purpose of avoiding a lawfully erected barricade closing a highway or roadway.

SECTION TWO. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
