FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [96] 60

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JAMES SHREWSBURY

An Ordinance to dedicate Softball Field Number 1 within Francis Park in Memory of Mr. Bernie "B.J." Leonard. Mr. Leonard was responsible for organizing and supervising an Interfaith Church Fast Pitch Softball League that played on this field from the Mid-1940's through 1994; and containing an emergency clause..

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The Softball Field to named Bernie "B.J." Leonard Field as a result of the passage of this Ordinance is further described as follows: The Ballfield Area known as Softball Field Number 1 located in Francis Park adjacent to Eichelberger Avenue, just West of Tamm Avenue.

Section Two. That a proper and fitting commemorative marker as approved by the Director of Parks of the City of St. Louis shall be located on said park grounds. Section Three. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
