

# St. Louis City Ordinance 63804

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [96] 76

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN VELMA BAILEY

An ordinance pertaining to parking in the 2900 block of University Street, permitting vehicles to park on either side of the street without regard to the direction of traffic and notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, all vehicles may park on either side of the street in the 2900 block of University Street without regard to the direction of traffic.

SECTION TWO. All vehicles parked in the 2900 block of University Street shall be so stopped or parked with the right hand wheels parallel to and within twelve (12) inches of the right hand curb, or with the left hand wheels parallel to and within twelve (12) inches of the left hand curb.

SECTION THREE. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
