

St. Louis City Ordinance 63814

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [96] 05

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN Mary Ross

An ordinance to temporarily close 19th, Benton, and Warren Streets, containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Benton and 19th Streets are hereby temporarily closed beginning at a point which is the southeast line of Benton Street and 19th Street and continuing generally northwest along a straight line 19 feet to a point which is 29 feet from the southeast line of Benton and 19th Street to the northwest corner of 19th and Benton Streets.

Section Two. Warren and 19th Streets are hereby temporarily closed, beginning at a point which is the southwest corner of Warren and 19th Streets and continuing generally eastward along a straight line to a point which is 21 feet from the southwest corner of Warren and 19th Streets and continuing along a straight line 43 feet to the northeast corner of 19th and Warren Streets.

Section Three. The passage of this ordinance being deemed necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
