

St. Louis City Ordinance 63846

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [96] 141

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN ALFRD WESSELS, JR.

An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, authorizing a supplemental appropriation amending Ordinance 63771 in the amount of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) from the Communications Fund 1117 fund balance to Department 190, Account 5836 for the 1996-97 Fiscal Year, which said funds are to be used to pay for communications infrastructure plan development, and containing an emergency clause.

WITNESSETH THAT,

WHEREAS, there exists an unappropriated fund balance in the Communications Fund 1117 in excess of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000); and

WHEREAS, the Charter, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes supplemental appropriations upon the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Pursuant to the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, there is hereby authorized a supplemental appropriation amending Ordinance 63771 in the amount of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) from the Communications Fund 1117 fund balance to Department 190, Account 5836 for the 1996-97 Fiscal Year, which said funds are to be used to pay for communication infrastructure plan development.

SECTION TWO: There is hereby created a Communications Infrastructure Plan Development Oversight Board whose responsibility it will be to select a consultant to aid in the July 12, 1996 plan development and to review and direct the work of the consultant. Such Board will consist of at least 5 members who will be the President of the Board of Public Service as chairperson, one appointee of the President of the Board of Aldermen, the Cable Communications Manager, Comptroller's Information Systems Manager, the Comptroller's Asset Manager, and any additional members as deemed necessary by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment.

SECTION THREE: Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
