

*St. Louis City Ordinance 63910*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [96] 243

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN VELMA BAILEY

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor and Comptroller of the City of St. Louis to execute, upon receipt of and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and other good and valuable consideration, a Quit Claim Deed to remise, release and forever quit-claim unto Louise Bonner, 1213 Redd Foxx Lane, St. Louis, Missouri, certain property known and numbered as 1215 Redd Foxx Lane, which property is more fully described herein; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Mayor and Comptroller are hereby authorized and directed to execute, upon receipt of and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and other good and valuable consideration, a Quit Claim Deed (attached hereto as Exhibit A) to remise, release and forever quit-claim unto Louise Bonner, 1213 Redd Foxx Lane, St. Louis, Missouri, certain property known and numbered as 1215 Redd Foxx Lane.

SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause. This ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety, and general welfare, shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and, as such, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

EXHIBIT A

QUIT CLAIM DEED

does by these presents Remise, Release, and Quit-Claim unto the said Party of the Second Part, the following described Real Estate, situated in the City of Saint Louis and State of Missouri, to-wit:

Block 2 Lot 27, of City Block Number 3736 of the City of St. Louis, together fronting 25 feet on the east line of Redd Foxx Lane, by a depth eastwardly of 137 feet 6 inches, more or less, known and numbered as 1215 Redd Foxx Lane.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all rights and appurtenances to the same belonging, unto the said Party of the Second Part, and to its heirs and assigns, so that neither the said Party of the First Part, not its heirs, nor any other person or persons for it or in its name or behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the aforesaid premises, or any part thereof, but they and every one of them shall, by these presents, be excluded and forever barred;
