

St. Louis City Ordinance 63984

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [96] 230

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG

An Ordinance pertaining to Soulard Market; authorizing and directing the Director of Public Utilities, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute an Agreement and Restrictive Covenant with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources for a grant to fund repairs at Soulard Market; appropriating from Soulard Market Renovation Fund 1010, Center 4140000, Account #5831000, \$10,000.00; appropriating from Soulard Market Fund 1119, Center 4140001, Account #5804000, \$10,000.00; and appropriating from the Board of Public Service Fund 1010, Center 9000000, Account #5507000 \$6,000.00, said appropriations to be used as matching funds for the grant funds for repair of Soulard Market and authorizing the Director of Public Utilities, on behalf of the City, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment to expend both the grant funds and the herein appropriated funds by entering into contracts or otherwise providing for repairs at Soulard Market and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Director of Public Utilities is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute an Agreement and Restrictive Covenant with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources for a grant to fund repairs at Soulard Market. Said Agreement and Restrictive Covenant shall conform substantially in words and figures to the attached Agreement and Restrictive Covenant which is made part of this Ordinance and is on file in the Register's Office.

SECTION TWO. The following funds are hereby appropriated to be used for repairs at Soulard Market and as matching funds for the grant contained herein:

Soulard Market Renovation Fund 1010, Center 4140000, Account #5831000	\$10,000.00
Soulard Market Fund 1119, Center 4140001, Account #5804000	\$10,000.00
Board of Public Service Fund 1010, Center 9000000, Account #5507000	\$ 6,000.00

SECTION THREE. The Director of Public Utilities is hereby authorized and directed, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to

expend the appropriated funds and the grant funds, by contract or otherwise, in a manner that is consistent with the provisions of said Agreement.

SECTION FOUR. Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
