

St. Louis City Ordinance 63989

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [96] 328

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN IRVING CLAY

An ordinance repealing ordinance 63894, approved on November 20, 1996, and authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to temporarily close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of traffic on Clara Avenue by blocking said traffic flow at a point Two Hundred (200) feet south of the south curb line of Cabanne Avenue, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Ordinance 63894, approved on November 20, 1996, is hereby repealed.

SECTION TWO: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close and barricade, for a period of six months, Clara Avenue at a point Two Hundred (200) feet south of the south curb line of Cabanne Avenue.

SECTION THREE: Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
