

St. Louis City Ordinance 64010

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [96] 330

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN FREEMAN BOSLEY, SR.

An ordinance pertaining to parking on certain designated blocks within the Third Ward of the City of St. Louis, permitting vehicles to park on either side of the street on said blocks without regard to the direction of traffic and notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, all vehicles may park on either side of the street in the 1500 block of Bremen Avenue without regard to the direction of traffic.

SECTION TWO. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, all vehicles may park on either side of the street in the 1900 block of Bremen Avenue without regard to the direction of traffic.

SECTION THREE. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, all vehicles may park on either side of the street in the 3800 block of Ashland Avenue without regard to the direction of traffic.

SECTION FOUR. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, all vehicles may park on either side of the street in the 3800 block of Sullivan Avenue without regard to the direction of traffic.

SECTION FIVE. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, all vehicles may park on either side of the street in the 3200 block of Palm Avenue without regard to the direction of traffic.

SECTION SIX. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, all vehicles

may park on either side of the street in the 3500 block of Palm Avenue without regard to the direction of traffic.

SECTION SEVEN. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, all vehicles may park on either side of the street in the 4200 block of North 22nd Street without regard to the direction of traffic.

SECTION EIGHT. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, all vehicles may park on either side of the street in the 3200 block of Harper Street without regard to the direction of traffic.

SECTION NINE. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 831.010 (1)(a) and Section 827.100 of Ordinance 57831, approved April 19, 1979, all vehicles may park on either side of the street in the 3500 block of Harper Street without regard to the direction of traffic.

SECTION TEN. All vehicles parked in accordance with the provisions of Sections One through Nine of this Ordinance shall be so stopped or parked with the right hand wheels parallel to and within twelve (12) inches of the right hand curb, or with the left hand wheels parallel to and within twelve (12) inches of the left hand curb.

SECTION THREE. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
