

St. Louis City Ordinance 64024

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [96] 296

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN STEPHEN CONWAY , JOSEPH D. RODDY

An ordinance recommended by the Board of Public Service to amend Ordinance 63189, dated July 1, 1994 which vacated public service rights for vehicle, equestrian and pedestrian travel in Park Avenue from Grand to Spring; Folsom Avenue from Grand westwardly 170' +/- 20' to vacated Folsom; Folsom Avenue from Spring eastwardly 250' +/- 15' to vacated Folsom; Cardinal Glennon Way from Folsom southwardly 160'; 15' wide north/south alley in C.B. 2124 bounded by Blaine on the south, Grand on the east, Folsom on the north and Spring on the west beginning at Folsom and continuing southwardly 110' to a point; 15' wide "L" shaped alley in C.B. 2125 bounded by Park on the north, Grand on the east, Folsom on the south, and Spring on the west beginning at Folsom and continuing to Spring in the City of Louis, Missouri, by extending the date Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital needs to complete the conditions of the ordinance.

SECTION ONE: Section Ten of Ordinance 63189 is amended to read "An affidavit stating that all of the conditions of this ordinance have been complied with must be submitted to the Board of Public Service for acceptance by January 31, 1999. If this affidavit is not submitted within the prescribed time, the ordinance will be null and void."
