

St. Louis City Ordinance 64094

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [97] 25

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN FREEMAN BOSLEY, SR.

An ordinance repealing Ordinance 63562, approved on October 25, 1995, and in lieu thereof enacting a new ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to permanently close Bremen Avenue at the north curb line of 20th Street and containing an emergency clause.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Ordinance 63562 approved on October 25, 1995 is hereby repealed.

SECTION TWO. The Director of Streets is hereby authorized and directed to permanently close Bremen Avenue at the north curb line of 20th Street.

SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
