

St. Louis City Ordinance 64185

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [97] 214

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JAMES SHREWSBURY

An ordinance pertaining to one-fourth-of-one-percent (1/4%) transportation sales tax; appropriating two hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$215,000.00) from the Transportation Fund, Fund Number 1714, Center 1600001, to be used to pay the Board of Election Commissioners for The City of St. Louis for the cost of placing the proposition to impose a one-fourth-of-one-percent transportation tax on the ballot of November 4, 1997 and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. There is hereby appropriated from the Transportation Fund, Fund Number 1714, Center 1600001, two hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$215,000.00) to be used to pay to the Board of Election Commissioners of The City of St. Louis for the cost of placing the proposition to impose a one-fourth-of-one percent transportation tax on the ballot of November 4, 1997.

SECTION TWO. Any funds appropriated hereunder and not used for placing said proposition on the ballot shall revert to the Transportation Fund.

SECTION THREE. Emergency clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
