

## *St. Louis City Ordinance 64189*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [97] 218

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN ROBERT RUGGERI

An Ordinance ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis a certain Grant Agreement offered by the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-47, Contract Number DTFA09-97-A-40058, dated September 29, 1997, for a maximum Federal obligation of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000), which is filed in the Office of the City Register, to implement a pilot mitigation program for eligible single family residences (as indicated in Baseline 1999 Contour Map) with approved mitigation measures including sound insulation, sales/transaction assistance and an avigation easement acquisition program; and containing an emergency clause.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis, a grant agreement offered by the United States of America, (the "Grant Agreement") acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-47, Contract Number DTFA09-97-A-40058, dated September 29, 1997, for a maximum federal obligation of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000), which is filed in the Office of the City Register as Document No. 26767 and made a part hereof, for the activities authorized in the Grant Agreement to provide for the implementation of a pilot mitigation program for eligible single family residences (as indicated Baseline 1999 Contour Map) with approved mitigation measures including sound insulation, sales/transaction assistance and an avigation easement acquisition program; are hereby ratified and approved.

SECTION TWO. All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations, covenants, agreements and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part hereof.

SECTION THREE. This being an ordinance providing for a Public Work and Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
