FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [97] 268

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN IRVING C. CLAY, JR. , STEPHEN GREGALI

An ordinance pertaining to the adoption of stray animals, amending Ordinance 60878, approved May 23, 1988, by repealing Section 10.04.170 of Section Two of said Ordinance and enacting a new ordinance pertaining to the adoption of stray animals.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Section 10.04.170 of Section Two of Ordinance 60878, approved may 23, 1988 is hereby repealed and enacted in lieu thereof is a new section pertaining to the adoption of stray animals.

SECTION TWO. Adoption of Strays. After notice required by Section 10.04.130 has been given, if the owner is known, and after the five days of holding for all stray animals required by Ordinance 60878, or any subsequent ordinance, has elapsed, then such animal may be released to any person upon payment of the fees required by this ordinance or any other ordinance and provided all other requirements for adoption are met. No dog or cat should be finally released unless procedures approved by the Health Commissioner to have it spayed or neutered have been followed.
