

## *St. Louis City Ordinance 64305*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [97] 313

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN MARTIE ABOUSSIE , MATTHEW VILLA

An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Commissioner of Disabled Services, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute an Agreement with the Community Development Agency for a grant to fund a rebate program to help defray the costs of construction of entrance ramps and unisex accessible toilets for renovations, alterations or change in use groups in four (4) areas of the City of St. Louis and authorizing the Commissioner of Disabled Services, on behalf of the City, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the funds by entering into contracts or otherwise for this program and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Commissioner of Disabled Services is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute an Agreement with the Community Development Agency for a grant to fund a rebate program to help defray the costs of the construction of entrance ramps and unisex accessible toilets for renovations, alterations or changes in use groups in four (4) areas of the City of St. Louis. Said Agreement shall be substantially in words and figures as the attached Agreement, which is made part of this Ordinance and is on file in the Register's Office.

SECTION TWO. The Commissioner of Disabled Services is hereby authorized and directed, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, by contract or otherwise to expend the funds received pursuant to the Agreement in a manner that is consistent with the provisions of said Agreement.

SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
