

St. Louis City Ordinance 64446

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [98] 103

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG

An ordinance declaring as a public necessity the acquisition of certain land for public use and authorizing the acquisition, by purchase or by condemnation proceedings, of certain land upon the recommendation of the Board of Public Service and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment; amending section one of Ordinance 63811 by the adding of real estate lot parcels 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, and 38 in City Block 206S which amends the legal description and use of said site for a prisoner detention facility, supporting facilities, parking lots and/or any other municipal facilities and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Section One of Ordinance 63811 is hereby amended to include additional lots in City Block 206S and to read as follows:

On the recommendation of the Board of Public Service and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, this ordinance declares, as a public necessity, the acquisition of the following described real property to be used as the site for a prisoner detention facility, supporting facilities, parking lots and/or any other municipal facilities for the City of St. Louis by the Department of Public Safety or any other department of the City of St. Louis is hereby authorized:

Lots 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, and 53 of the Henry Chouteau Estate and in City Block 206 South of the City of St. Louis and more or less bounded North by the South line of Walnut St.; South by the North line of Clark Street not including the lots 39, 40, and 41 in said City Block 206 South; West by the East line of Tucker (formerly 12th Street) Blvd. and East by the West line of Eleventh Street.

Section Two. All other sections and provisions of Ordinance 63811 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section Three. This being an ordinance deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and to provide for a public work and improvement, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
