

St. Louis City Ordinance 64452

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [98] 114

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN GREGORY CARTER

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to permanently close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of traffic on Lucille Avenue by blocking said traffic flow three hundred and seventy-five (375) feet from the west curb line of Goodfellow Boulevard, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to permanently close and barricade Lucille Avenue three hundred and seventy-five (375) feet from the west curb line of Goodfellow Boulevard.

SECTION TWO: Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
