

## *St. Louis City Ordinance 64489*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [98] 128

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN FREEMAN R. BOSLEY, SR.

AAAn ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor and the Comptroller of the city of St. Louis to execute the dedication plat for additional right of way of certain city-owned property located in City Block 1175, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of St. Louis are hereby authorized and directed to execute the dedication plat for additional right of way of certain real estate owned by the City of St. Louis, described as follows:

A 14 feet wide strip of land 70 feet long in the northeast corner of Hyde Park in City Block 1175, bounded in the north by the southerly line of Bremen Avenue (50 feet wide), bounded on the east by the westerly line of Blair Avenue (60 feet wide), located in the City of St. Louis, Missouri, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe in the northeast corner of City Block 1175, said corner being at the intersection of the south line of said Bremen Avenue with the west line of said Blair Avenue; thence along the south line of said Bremen Avenue south 67 degrees 03 minutes 47 seconds west 70.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence leaving the south line of said Bremen Avenue south 23 degrees 18 minutes 52 seconds east 14.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence parallel to the south line of said Bremen Avenue north 67 degrees 03 minutes 47 seconds east 70.00 feet to the west line of said Blair Avenue; thence along said west line of Blair Avenue north 23 degrees 18 minutes 52 seconds west 14.00 feet to the point of beginning and containing 980 square feet or 0.0225 acres, more or less.

SECTION TWO. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
