

St. Louis City Ordinance 64507

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [98] 169

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Port Authority Commission of the City of St. Louis (◆Port◆) and the Mayor and Comptroller, on behalf of the City of St. Louis (◆City◆) to enter into and execute a License Agreement with the Terminal Railroad Association of St. Louis (◆Terminal◆) for the purpose of granting the Port and the City the right to enter upon a portion of the Merchants Elevated Structure between Eads Bridge and Carr Street for the purpose of the installation and maintenance of accent lighting, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Port Authority Commission of the City of St. Louis (◆Port◆) and the City of St. Louis (◆City◆) are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute a License Agreement (◆Agreement◆) with the Terminal Railroad Association of St. Louis (◆Terminal◆) for the purpose of granting the Port and the City the right to enter upon a portion of the Merchants Elevated Structure between Eads Bridge and Carr Street for the purpose of the installation and maintenance of accent lighting. Said Agreement shall substantially read in words and figures as the attached Exhibit 1.

SECTION TWO. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
