

# *St. Louis City Ordinance 64541*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [98] 216

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to temporarily close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of traffic along an east-west alley, known as Elvira Alley, in city block 441 by blocking said traffic flow at the west curb line of Tucker Boulevard, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close and barricade, for a period of six months, the flow of traffic along an east-west alley, known as Elvira Alley, in city block 441 by blocking said traffic flow at the west curb line of Tucker Boulevard.

SECTION TWO: Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
