

St. Louis City Ordinance 64542

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [98] 217

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN CRAIG SCHMID

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to temporarily close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on Oregon Street by blocking said vehicular and pedestrian traffic flow at a point 150 feet north of the north curblineline of Miami Street, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close, barricade or otherwise impede, for a period of six months, the flow of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on Oregon Street by blocking said vehicular and pedestrian traffic flow at a point 150 feet north of the north curblineline of Miami Street.

SECTION TWO: Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
