An ordinance pertaining to the Board of Building Appeals; authorizing the Board of Building Appeals to appoint hearing officers to hear and render decisions on appeals filed with the Board of Building Appeals.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Notwithstanding any ordinance to the contrary, the Board of Building Appeals may appoint a hearing officer to hear and render a decision on any appeal filed with the Board of Building Appeals.

SECTION TWO. The hearing officer shall be an attorney and on an approved list of attorneys who have administrative law experience. The Director of Public Safety shall compile and maintain said list.

SECTION THREE. Said hearing officer shall have such rights, responsibilities and duties as the Board of Building Appeals and the appellants shall have the same rights as an appellant appearing before the Board of Building Appeals, including the right to appeal pursuant to Missouri's Administrative Procedure and Review Act.
