

St. Louis City Ordinance 64711

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [99] 127

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN STEPHEN GREGALI

An ordinance prohibiting any person from making a replica, facsimile or counterfeit of any insurance identification card issued by a motor vehicle insurer or of any proof of financial responsibility certificate issued by the state of Missouri, further prohibiting any person from erasing, changing or altering any insurance identification card issued by a motor vehicle insurer or any proof of financial responsibility certificate issued by the state of Missouri or knowingly using or displaying any insurance identification card issued by a motor vehicle insurer or any proof of financial responsibility certificate issued by the state of Missouri; and containing a penalty clause and an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Insurance identification card, Counterfeiting. No person shall make a replica, facsimile or counterfeit of any insurance identification card issued by a motor vehicle insurer or of any proof of financial responsibility certificate issued by the state of Missouri, nor shall any person erase, change or alter any insurance identification card issued by a motor vehicle insurer or any proof of financial responsibility certificate issued by the state of Missouri or knowingly use or display a replica, facsimile or counterfeit insurance identification card issued by a motor vehicle insurer or proof of financial responsibility certificate issued by the state of Missouri.

SECTION TWO. Any person found guilty of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment for not more than Ninety (90) days or by both such fine and imprisonment

SECTION THREE. Emergency clause.

This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
