

St. Louis City Ordinance 64713

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [99] 113

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN FRANCIS G. SLAY

An ordinance recommended by the Board of Public Service and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment authorizing the Building Commissioner to enter into contracts for the demolition and abatement of various abandoned or condemned buildings pursuant to the authority of Ordinance 64419 and Ordinance 64641; appropriating the sum of Eleven Million Dollars (\$11,000,000.) from the proceeds of the sale of bonds which was authorized by said Ordinances, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Building Commissioner is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the demolition and abatement of various abandoned or condemned buildings pursuant to the authority of Ordinance 64419 and Ordinance 64641. All said contracts shall be approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment.

SECTION TWO. There is hereby appropriated, for said purpose, out of the proceeds realized from the sale of bonds for the purpose of the demolition and abatement of various abandoned or condemned buildings as authorized by Ordinance 64419 and Ordinance 64641 the amount of Eleven Million Dollars (\$11,000,000).

SECTION THREE. This being an ordinance providing for public work and for the immediate preservation of health and safety it is declared to be an emergency within the meaning of Section 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
