

St. Louis City Ordinance 64760

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [99] 141

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JAMES SHREWSBURY

An Ordinance, recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, ratifying and adopting the actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis a certain grant agreement offered by the United States of America (the "Grant Agreement"), acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-54, Contract Number DTFA 09-99-A-40037, dated August 4, 1999, for a maximum Federal obligation of Six Million Seven Hundred Four Dollars (\$6,000,704), which is filed in the Office of the City Register, to provide for the Functional Replacement of the Berkeley High School Complex (Phase 4) as furthered described and depicted in the Grant Agreement; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The actions of the Mayor and the Comptroller in accepting and executing on behalf of the City of St. Louis, a grant agreement offered by the United States of America (the "Grant Agreement"), acting through the Federal Aviation Administration of the United States Department of Transportation, the Grant Agreement being for Project Number 3-29-0085-54, Contract Number DTFA 09-99-A-40037, dated August 4, 1999, for a maximum Federal obligation of Six Million Seven Hundred Four Dollars (\$6,000,704), which is filed in the Office of the City Register as document number 32596 and made a part hereof, for the activities authorized in the Grant Agreement to provide for the Functional Replacement of the Berkeley High School Complex (Phase 4) as furthered described and depicted in the Grant Agreement.

SECTION TWO. All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations, covenants, agreements and assurances contained in the project application and the incorporated materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part hereof.

SECTION THREE. This being an ordinance providing for a Public Work and Improvement Program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as

defined in Article IV, Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
