

St. Louis City Ordinance 64885

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [99] 283

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG

An ordinance recommended by the Planning and Urban Design Commission on January 7, 2000 and approved by the Board of Public Service on January , 2000, to rescind Board of Public Service Permit #51912 approved July 16, 1957, approving a Community Unit Plan known as the St. Louis Housing Authority Low-Rent Housing Project, being Project MO-1-7, Phases I and II, and so as to include the described parcels of land in City Blocks 410 and 475; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The Community Unit Plan designation, known as the St. Louis Housing Authority Low-Rent Housing Project, being Project MO-1-7, Phases I and II, as established pursuant to Board of Public Service Permit #51912 approved July 16, 1957, and as currently administered under the provisions of Section 26.80.070 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis - 1994, of certain real property located in City Blocks 410 and 475, is hereby rescinded, real property being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in City Block 475, said point being the center line of Chouteau Avenue at the point of intersection thereof with the center line of Raymond Tucker Memorial Boulevard (also known as South 12th Street); thence, from said point southwardly along said center line of Raymond Tucker Memorial Boulevard (also known as South 12th Street), to a point, said point being the point of intersection thereof with the center line of Lafayette Avenue; thence, from said point westwardly along said center line of Lafayette Avenue, to a point, said point being the intersection thereof with the center line of South 14th Street; thence, from said point northwardly along said center line of South 14th Street, to a point, said point being the point of intersection thereof with the center line of Chouteau Avenue; thence, from said point eastwardly along said center line of Chouteau Avenue, to a point, said point being the point of intersection thereof with the center line of Raymond Tucker Memorial Boulevard (also known as South 12th Street), said point being the point of beginning.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance being necessary for the preservation of public health, safety and welfare, shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon approval by the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
