

## *St. Louis City Ordinance 64940*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [00] 13

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JAMES F. SHREWSBURY

An ordinance recommended and approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment authorizing and directing the Director of Airports and the Comptroller for the City of St. Louis (the "City") to enter into and execute on behalf of the City a Use Agreement (the "Agreement") at Lambert- St. Louis International Airport (the "Airport") between the City and Chautauqua Airline, Inc., d/b/a Trans World Express, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York (the "Airline"), granting to the Airline, subject to the terms, covenants, and conditions of the Agreement, certain rights, licenses, services, and privileges in connection with and on the Airport to the Airline, which may include the leasing of certain premises and facilities more fully described in the Agreement that was approved by the City's Airport Commission and the City's Board of Estimate and Apportionment, and is attached hereto as Attachment "A" and made a part hereof; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Director of Airports and the Comptroller for the City of St. Louis (the "City") are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the City a Use Agreement (the "Agreement") at Lambert-St. Louis International Airport (the "Airport") between the City and Chautauqua Airline, Inc., d/b/a Trans World Express, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York (the "Airline"), granting to the Airline, subject to the terms, covenants, and conditions of the Agreement, certain rights, licenses, services, and privileges in connection with and on the Airport to the Airline, which may include the leasing of certain premises and facilities at the Airport more fully described in the Agreement that was approved by the City's Airport Commission and the City's Board of Estimate and Apportionment, and is to read in words and figures as set out in Attachment "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION TWO. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, or safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV. Sections 20 of the City Charter and shall become effective immediately upon its approval by the Mayor of the City.
