

St. Louis City Ordinance 64986

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN IRVING C. CLAY, JR.

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to temporarily close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of traffic on Chamberlain Avenue by blocking said traffic flow at the west curb line of Belt Avenue, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close and barricade, for a period of six months, Chamberlain Avenue at the west curb line of Belt Avenue.

SECTION TWO: Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately
