

St. Louis City Ordinance 64990

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN DIONNE FLOWERS

An ordinance establishing two way stop sites for all east-west traffic traveling on Switzer Avenue approaching the intersection of Switzer Avenue and Drury Lane; all north-south traffic on Frederick Street approaching the intersection of Frederick Street and Baden Avenue; and all east-west traffic on Hornsby Avenue approaching the intersection of Hornsby Avenue and Partridge Avenue and containing an emergency clause.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. There are hereby established two way stop sites for east-west traffic traveling on Switzer Avenue approaching the intersection of Switzer Avenue and Drury Lane; all north-south traffic on Frederick Street approaching the intersection of Frederick Street and Baden Avenue; and all east-west traffic on Hornsby Avenue approaching the intersection of Hornsby Avenue and Partridge Avenue. The director of streets is hereby authorized and directed to install stop signs at said location to regulate traffic approaching these intersections.

SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
