

St. Louis City Ordinance 65013

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE
BOARD BILL NO. [00] 83

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JAMES F. SHREWSBURY

An ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment authorizing a First Supplemental Appropriation in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) from the Airport Passenger Facility Charge Fund Account into the Pilot Noise Mitigation Program Ordinance 64192 approved November 17, 1997, for the payment of costs authorized therein; and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, the Pilot Noise Mitigation Ordinance 64192 approved November 17, 1997, authorized a multi-year public work and improvement program (the "Program") at Lambert–St. Louis International Airport (the "Airport"), providing for the acquisition of certain avigation easements for noise mitigation and consisting of a voluntary acoustical treatment program, a voluntary avigation easement purchasing program, and a voluntary sales transaction assistance program for residential property subject to certain noise exposures and located within certain geographical boundaries, as recommended and detailed in the approved Airport's Updated FAR PART 150 Noise Compatibility Study, at an estimated total cost of Seventy Eight Million Dollars (\$78,000,000), authorized an initial appropriation of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000), and contained an emergency clause; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize a First Supplemental Appropriation in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) from the Passenger Facility Charge Fund Account established under authority of Ordinance No. 62501, Section 6, approved February 10, 1992, into the Pilot Noise Mitigation Ordinance 64192 approved November 17, 1997 in order to continue the Program and the payment of costs authorized therein.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. There is hereby authorized a First Supplemental Appropriation in the total amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) from the Passenger Facility Charge Fund Account established under authority of Ordinance No. 62501, Section 6, Approved February 10, 1992, into the Pilot Noise Mitigation Program Ordinance 64192 approved November 17, 1997, for the payment of costs authorized therein.

SECTION TWO. This being an Ordinance providing for a public works and improvement program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20, of the City Charter and shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
