

St. Louis City Ordinance 65103

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE
BOARD BILL NO. 212 [00]

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN CRAIG N. SCHMID

An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to temporarily close, barricade or otherwise impede the flow of traffic on Judith Court by blocking said traffic flow at the south curb line of Gasconade Street, and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The Director of Streets is hereby authorized to temporarily close and barricade, for a period of six months, Judith Court at the south curb line of Gasconade Street.

SECTION TWO: Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
