

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 111 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY**

2 An ordinance pertaining to the Civilian Oversight Board, permitting appointed
3 members of the Civilian Oversight Board to park, without payment of fees, at any
4 parking meter or contrary to posted NO PARKING ZONES, with exceptions; requiring
5 each authorized individual to display an approved parking placard; further requiring that
6 each placard display the ordinance number and prohibiting the unauthorized duplication
7 of such placards.

8 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

9 **SECTION ONE.** The appointed members of the Civilian Oversight Board,
10 including the Civilian Oversight Board’s Executive Director, when on official duty, shall
11 be allowed to park, without payment of fees, at any parking meter or contrary to posted
12 NO PARKING ZONES. In no event will parking be allowed in front of fire plugs, mail
13 boxes, bus stops, wheelchair ramps, within 30 feet of a curblin of any intersection, nor
14 within disabled parking spaces (except, in the case of a disabled parking space, parking
15 will be allowed if the vehicle displays a Missouri Permanent Disabled Placard or a
16 license plate for the disabled).

17 **SECTION TWO.** Each authorized individual shall display one (1) placard,
18 approved by the Executive Director of Civilian Oversight Board, in either the front or
19 rear window of private or city vehicles, to indicate that the individual is on official city
20 business and is exempt from parking fees, citations, and parking tickets, in accordance
21 with this ordinance, during normal working hours. The Executive Director of the Civilian

1 Oversight Board shall only issue such placards to the seven appointees to the Civilian
2 Oversight Board and to himself or herself as Executive Director of the Civilian Oversight
3 Board. The Executive Director of the Civilian Oversight Board shall have the authority to
4 request cancellation of parking tickets issued contrary to this ordinance.

5 **SECTION THREE.** Each placard shall prominently display the number assigned
6 to this ordinance by the Register of the City of St. Louis. Any duplication or
7 photocopying of such placards is prohibited. Each placard must be returned to the
8 Executive Director when its holder no longer serves on the Civilian Oversight Board or,
9 in the case of a placard issued to the Executive Director, to the Director of Public Safety
10 upon the termination of the Executive Director's service. Any placard issued pursuant to
11 this ordinance is void if its holder no longer serves on the Civilian Oversight Board or as
12 its Executive Director.
