

1 **BOARD BILL #12 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN GREGORY CARTER**

2 An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Fire Chief, on behalf of the City of  
3 St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with the Federal Emergency  
4 Management Agency, to fund a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response  
5 project, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, and to expend funds  
6 by entering into contracts or otherwise for grant purposes and containing an emergency  
7 clause.

8 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

9 **SECTION ONE.** The Fire Chief is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of  
10 the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with Federal  
11 Emergency Management Agency to fund a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency  
12 Response project. Said Grant Agreement shall be substantially in words and figures the  
13 same as the attached Agreement, which is made part of this Ordinance and is on file with  
14 the Register's Office.

15 **SECTION TWO.** The Fire Chief is hereby authorized and directed, upon  
16 approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the funds, which are  
17 hereby appropriated for said purpose, by entering into contracts or otherwise received  
18 pursuant to the Grant Agreement, totaling \$3,215,483.00 in a manner that is consistent  
19 with the provisions of said Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and shall  
20 become part of the Ordinance.

21 **SECTION THREE.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the  
22 immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an  
23 immediate measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the

- 1 Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective
- 2 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
