

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 124 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN CHRIS CARTER**

2 An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, authorizing a  
3 supplemental appropriation; amending Ordinance \_\_\_\_\_, commonly referred to as the City of  
4 St. Louis Annual Operating Plan for Fiscal Year 2015-2016; appropriating and setting apart the  
5 sum of Three Hundred Nine Thousand Sixty Six Dollars (\$309,066) from the Parking Division  
6 Fund for the operations and expenses of the Treasurer Department’s Office of Financial  
7 Empowerment Fund 1116, notwithstanding or limiting any portion of the funds to be allocated to  
8 the City’s general revenue fund as designated in statute R.S. Mo. 82.485; and containing an  
9 emergency clause.

10 **WITNESSETH THAT,**

11 **WHEREAS**, the Charter of The City of St. Louis, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes  
12 supplemental appropriations when any accruing, unappropriated City revenue is available  
13 and whenever an appropriation exceeds the amount required for the purpose for which it has  
14 been made and when the Board of Estimate and Apportionment recommends same;

15 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

16 **SECTION ONE.**

17 Pursuant to the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, there is  
18 hereby appropriated a supplemental appropriation, amending Ordinance \_\_\_\_\_ in the amount  
19 of Three Hundred Nine Thousand Sixty Six Dollars (\$309,066) from the Parking Division Fund  
20 for the operations and expenses of the Treasurer Department’s Office of Financial Empowerment  
21 Fund 1116 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 as detailed in Exhibit A, notwithstanding or  
22 limiting any portion of the funds to be allocated to the City’s general revenue fund as designated  
23 in statute R.S. Mo. 82.485.

1    **SECTION TWO.**

2           Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance providing for the preservation of public  
3 health and safety and providing for current expenses of the City government, it is hereby  
4 declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of  
5 the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective  
6 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
