

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 144 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN ANTONIO FRENCH**

2 An ordinance pertaining to public parking at City Hall, mandating that the first
3 hour of parking on the City Hall lot be provided free of charge during normal business
4 hours, by amending Section 17.62.150 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis and
5 Section 17.62.150 of Section One of Ordinance 62101; and containing an emergency
6 clause.

7 **WHEREAS**, the amendment to the existing ordinance and Revised Code of the
8 City of St. Louis is shown in boldface in the body of this bill.

9 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

10 **SECTION 1.** Section 17.62.150 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis and
11 Section 17.62.150 of Section One of Ordinance 62101 are hereby amended to read as
12 follows:

13 The City Hall parking area lying directly south **and southwest** of City Hall and
14 abutting on Clark Avenue, except that part described in Section 17.62.160, shall
15 be set aside for the exclusive use by members of the public who are visiting or
16 doing business at City Hall between the hours of eight (8) a.m. and five (5) p.m.
17 of each day, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. The Parking Commission is
18 directed to establish, and the Parking Supervisor is directed to administer,
19 a parking management program, including parking control devices,
20 parking control signs, a schedule of fees, operating hours, the reservation
21 of parking meter spaces on the public streets immediately adjacent to City Hall,
22 and other policies and procedures as necessary to ensure adequate parking for

1 visitors to City Hall. **Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this**
2 **ordinance or Chapter 17 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis,**
3 **members of the public who are visiting or doing business**
4 **at City Hall between the hours of eight (8) a.m. and five (5) p.m. of each day,**
5 **except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, shall not pay a fee for their first**
6 **hour of parking at the City Hall parking area lying directly south and**
7 **southwest of City Hall and abutting on Clark Avenue, except that part**
8 **described in Section 17.62.160.**

9 **SECTION 2.** Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of
10 public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within
11 the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis
12 and therefore shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the
13 mayor.
