

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 147 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY,**  
2 **PRESIDENT LEWIS E. REED, ALDERMAN ANTONIO FRENCH**

3 An Ordinance, recommended and approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment,  
4 authorizing an amendment to the City of St. Louis' Annual Operating Budget Ordinance 69432  
5 approved June 28, 2013 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014,  
6 pertaining to municipal general revenue appropriations for services to be consolidated as a result  
7 of local control of the Police Department as detailed in Exhibit A and containing an emergency  
8 clause.

9 WHEREAS, Section Three of the Annual Operating Budget Ordinance 69432 approved June 28,  
10 2013 appropriated the sum of Four Hundred Seventy Nine Million Three Hundred Eight  
11 Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Six Dollars (\$479,308,266) in municipal general revenue for the  
12 support, maintenance and operations of the several Departments, Boards, Offices, etc. of the City  
13 Government for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014 with said  
14 appropriations included in detail by department;

15 WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 69489, the City accepted responsibility, ownership and  
16 liability as successor-in-interest for contractual obligations, indebtedness and other lawful  
17 obligations of the board of police commissioners of the St. Louis Police Department effective  
18 September 1, 2013 toward the establishment of a locally controlled municipal police department  
19 which will entail the consolidation of certain personnel and services across various City  
20 departments and require the reallocation of said appropriated municipal general revenue among  
21 those departments to match the revised funding requirements resulting from the consolidation;

1 WHEREAS, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment has subsequently recommended and  
2 approved the revised funding amounts for the various departments affected by the consolidation  
3 of services resulting from local control of the Police Department.

4 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

5 SECTION ONE. There shall be established a municipal police division within the department of  
6 public safety of the City of St. Louis for the purposes of: Preserving the public peace, welfare  
7 and order; preventing crime and arresting suspected offenders; enforcing the laws of the state and  
8 the ordinances of the city; exercising all powers available to a police force generally under  
9 applicable state law; and regulating and licensing all private watchman, private detectives, or  
10 private policemen serving or acting as such.

11 SECTION TWO. The detailed appropriation amounts of municipal general revenue for various  
12 City departments referenced in Section Three of the Annual Operating Budget Ordinance 69432  
13 approved June 28, 2013 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014, are  
14 hereby amended to reflect revised funding requirements due to the consolidation of services  
15 arising from local control of the Police department as detailed in Exhibit A.

16 SECTION THREE. This being an ordinance for the establishment of a municipal police force  
17 and an amendment to a general appropriation ordinance that provides for the current expenses of  
18 the City of St. Louis related to a municipal police force, it is hereby declared to be an emergency  
19 measure pursuant to Article IV, Sections 19 and 20, of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and  
20 shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
