

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 161** **INTRODUCED BY: ALDERWOMAN KREWSON**

3 An ordinance adopted pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement Act, Sections 70.210 to
4 70.325, inclusive, of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, and authorizing the City of St. Louis, by
5 and through its Department of Human Services (“DHS”) to enter into an Intergovernmental
6 Cooperation Agreement with the Bi-State Development Agency of the Missouri-Illinois
7 Metropolitan District (doing business as “Metro”) for the purpose of appropriating funds for
8 DHS to provide transit passes for certain persons in need, which passes DHS will acquire from
9 Metro at a discounted rate, terms pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto
10 and incorporated by reference into this Ordinance, containing a severability clause and a
11 governance clause.

12 WHEREAS, the City of St. Louis, Missouri (the “City”) is authorized and empowered under the
13 Intergovernmental Agreement Act, Sections 70.210 to 70.325, inclusive, of the revised statutes
14 of Missouri, to contract and cooperate with the Bi-State Development Agency of the Missouri-
15 Illinois Metropolitan District (“Metro”); and

16 WHEREAS, The City and the District desire to enter into such Intergovernmental Agreement in
17 substantially the form attached to this Authorizing Ordinance (the “Intergovernmental
18 Agreement”); and

19 WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City hereby find it is advisable, necessary, and in the
20 best interests of the City of enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement.

21 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

22 **SECTION ONE.** The Board of Aldermen hereby confirms its approval of the
23 Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement. The Board of Aldermen further finds and determines
24 that it is necessary and desirable to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement with the Bi-State

1 Development Agency of the Missouri-Illinois Metropolitan District (“Metro”), in substantially
2 the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

3 **SECTION TWO.** The City is hereby authorized to enter into, and the Mayor and the
4 Comptroller and such other officers of the City as are appropriate are hereby authorized and
5 directed to execute, seal, attest and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, The Intergovernmental
6 Agreement, with such changes as are consistent with the intent of this Authorizing Ordinance, as
7 shall be approved by the appropriate officers of the City executing the Intergovernmental
8 Agreement, such officers’ signatures thereon being conclusive evidence of their approval thereof
9 without further action of the Board of Aldermen necessary to authorize such changes by the
10 Mayor and the Comptroller or their designated representatives.

11 **SECTION THREE.** It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Aldermen that each
12 and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from
13 each and every other part, section and subsection, separately and independently of any other part,
14 section and subsection. In the event that any part, section or subsection of this Ordinance shall be
15 determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections, and
16 subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect, unless the court making such finding
17 shall determine that the valid portions standing alone are incomplete and are incapable of being
18 executed in accord with the legislative intent.

19 **SECTION FOUR.** In the event of any inconsistency between the provisions of this Ordinance
20 and the provisions of any prior ordinances, the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.

21 **SECTION FIVE.** This Ordinance shall be governed exclusively by and construed in
22 accordance with the applicable laws of the State of Missouri.
