

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 216 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY,**
2 **ALDERMAN FRANK WILLIAMSON, ALDERMAN ANTONIO FRENCH,**
3 **ALDERWOMAN CHRISTINE INGRASSIA, ALDERMAN CHRIS CARTER,**

6 An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, authorizing a
7 supplemental appropriation; amending Ordinance 69432, commonly referred to as the City of St.
8 Louis Annual Operating Plan for Fiscal Year 2013-2014; appropriating and reducing in the
9 amount of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) from the Water Division, as
10 hereinafter detailed; and containing an emergency clause.

11 **WHEREAS**, the Annual Budget was established under authority of Ordinance No.
12 69432 approved on June 28, 2013; and

13 **WHEREAS**, contained within this budget, was an appropriation of One Million Three
14 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000) to the Water Division, Line Item 5659000,
15 Professional Services, Fund 1510; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Line Item 5659000 does not specifically outline the details of Fund
17 1510 and per the typical contract and appropriation process a contract expending funds, like
18 those in Line Item 565900, have been required to have specific approval in writing through
19 an additional ordinance or the expressed written approval of the Board of Estimate and
20 Apportionment ; and

21 **WHEREAS**, a portion of the Professional Services line item of Two Hundred and
22 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) may be for the use of a Veolia Contract which was not

1 specifically outlined or detailed in the City of St. Louis Annual Operating Plan for Fiscal
2 Year 2013-2014; and

3 **WHEREAS**, a possible change in the typical contract process may occur related to a
4 possible contract with Veolia based upon an October 4, 2103 letter of opinion from the City
5 Counselor to the City Comptroller indicating a different procedure other than the typical
6 contract process used over the past years by the City; and

7 **WHEREAS**, this Board wishes to ensure that any such contract go through the
8 typical contract and appropriation process of the City including specific and distinct review
9 and written approval by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the Charter of The City of St. Louis, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes
11 supplemental appropriations and the Board of Aldermen may reduce an appropriation once
12 made and when the Board of Estimate and Apportionment recommends same;

13 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

14 **SECTION ONE.**

15 Pursuant to the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, there is
16 hereby appropriated a supplemental appropriation, amending Ordinance 69432, by reducing the
17 amount of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) from Line Item 5659000,
18 Professional Services, Fund 1510 of the Water Division.

19 **SECTION TWO.**

20 Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance providing for the preservation of public
21 health and safety and providing for current expenses of the City government, it is hereby
22 declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of

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- 1 the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective
- 2 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

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
