SECTION 3.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE

1

2 This ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
3 peace, health and safety is declared to be an emergency ordinance pursuant to Article IV, Section
4 19 and 20 of the City Charter.
