

**BOARD BILL NO. 235 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOHN COLLINS-MUHAMMAD**

1 Pursuant to Ordinance 68937, an ordinance authorizing the honorary naming of streets,  
2 Pastor Steven Shepard Lane will begin at the intersection of Shreve Avenue and Margareta  
3 Avenue and run west on Margareta Avenue to Marcus Avenue.

4 **WHEREAS**, Pastor Steven Shepard has diligently the congregation of St. Peter’s AME  
5 Church as Senior Pastor; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Pastor Steven Shepard and his congregation opened the doors of their church  
7 to give shelter to those who had none during this period of extreme cold weather; and

8 **WHEREAS**, under the leadership of Pastor Shepard St. Peter’s AME Church has  
9 demonstrated that it is an anchor in the community, truly a place of shelter in the storm;

10 **WHEREAS**, Pastor Steven Shepard’s leadership and love for those of us who are least  
11 fortunate should be an example to us all, thus an honorary street name is a fitting honor  
12 which only begins to communicate the impact Pastor Steven Shepard has on the  
13 community.

14 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

15 **SECTION 1.** Pastor Steven Shepard Lane will begin at the intersection of Shreve Avenue  
16 and Margareta Avenue, and run west of Margareta Avenue to Marcus Avenue.

17 **SECTION 2.** Upon receipt of payment for manufacturing and installing the respective  
18 honorary street signs, the Director of Streets shall install the honorary street signs, Pastor  
19 Steven Shepard Lane, will begin at the intersection of Shreve Avenue and Margareta

- 1 Avenue, and if adequate funds are received, the Director of Streets shall also install such
- 2 an honorary street sign at the intersection of Marcus Avenue and Margareta Avenue.
