

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 256 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOSEPH VACCARO**

2 An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, authorizing a
3 supplemental appropriation; amending Ordinance 69154, commonly referred to as the City of St.
4 Louis Annual Operating Plan for Fiscal Year 2012-2013; appropriating Forty Thousand Dollars
5 (\$40,000) from excess payments on water bills and personal and real property tax bills received
6 into the “Heat-up St. Louis Fund”, “The Big Brothers Big Sisters of Eastern Missouri Fund,”
7 “The Backstoppers, Inc. Fund” and the “Pet Spay, Neuter and Microchip Assistance Fund” and
8 containing an emergency clause.

9 **WITNESSETH THAT,**

10 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ordinances 68816, 68846 and 69043 revenues from excess
11 payments on water bills and personal and real property tax bills have been accruing to the
12 “Heat-up St. Louis Fund”, “The Big Brothers Big Sisters of Eastern Missouri Fund,” “The
13 Backstoppers, Inc. Fund” and the “Pet Spay, Neuter and Microchip Assistance Fund” and;

14 **WHEREAS**, the Charter of The City of St. Louis, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes
15 supplemental appropriations when any accruing, unappropriated City revenue is available
16 and whenever an appropriation exceeds the amount required for the purpose for which it has
17 been made and when the Board of Estimate and Apportionment recommends same;

18 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

19 **SECTION ONE.**

20 Pursuant to the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, there is
21 hereby appropriated a supplemental appropriation, amending Ordinance 69154 in the amount of
22 Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) from excess payments on water bills and personal and real
23 property tax bills received into the “Heat-up St. Louis Fund”, “The Big Brothers Big Sisters of

1 Eastern Missouri Fund,” “The Backstoppers, Inc. Fund” and the “Pet Spay, Neuter and
2 Microchip Assistance Fund” as detailed in Exhibit A.

3 **SECTION TWO.**

4 In no event shall the Comptroller draw warrants on the Treasurer of the City of St. Louis for an
5 amount greater than the amount of the actual proceeds received into any of the funds contained
6 in this ordinance.

7 **SECTION THREE.**

8 Emergency Clause. This being a general appropriation ordinance and providing for
9 current expenses of the City government, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
10 within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis
11 and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval
12 by the Mayor.
