

BOARD BILL NO. 260 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN LARRY ARNOWITZ

1 An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Sheriff of the City of St. Louis, on behalf of
2 the Mayor and the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a Grant Agreement with the
3 Missouri Department of Public Safety, to fund the Deputy Sheriff Salary
4 Supplementation Program, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment,
5 and to expend funds by entering into contracts or otherwise for grant purposes and
6 containing an emergency clause.

7 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

8 **SECTION ONE.** The Mayor and the Sheriff of the City of St. Louis, are hereby
9 authorized and directed, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute a
10 Grant Agreement the Missouri Department of Public Safety to fund the Program.

11 **SECTION TWO.** The Sheriff of the City of St. Louis is hereby authorized and directed,
12 upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend the funds, which
13 are hereby appropriated for said purpose, by entering into contracts or otherwise received
14 pursuant to the Grant Agreement, totaling \$130,016.63, in a manner that is consistent
15 with the provisions of said Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and shall
16 become part of the ordinance.

17 **SECTION 3.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate
18 preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate
19 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City
20 of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its
21 passage and approval by the Mayor.
