

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 29 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN STEPHEN CONWAY**

2 An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of the Department of Human
3 Services, via the St. Louis Area Agency on Aging, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to accept a
4 Grant Award from the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services in the amount of
5 \$70,000.00 and to expend those funds for Long Term Care Rebalancing Opportunities services
6 as set forth in the Notice of Grant Award and Grant Agreement and attached as Exhibit A;
7 appropriating said funds and authorizing the Director of the Department of Human Services,
8 upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend such funds as permitted
9 by the Notice of Grant Award and Grant Award Agreement; and containing an Emergency
10 Clause.

11 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

12 **SECTION ONE.** The Director of the Department of Human Services, on behalf of the
13 City of St. Louis, is hereby authorized to accept a Grant Award from the Missouri Department of
14 Health and Senior Services to enter into a Grant Award Agreement for funds in the amount of
15 \$70,000.00 which will be used to provide Long Term Care Rebalancing Opportunities services
16 for senior citizens residing in Long Term Care facilities as set forth in Exhibit A, the Notice of
17 Grant Award. Said Grant Agreement shall be substantially in words and figures the same as the
18 attached Grant Agreement, which are made part of this Ordinance and are on file in the
19 Register’s Office.

20 **SECTION TWO.** The Director of the Department of Human Services is hereby
21 authorized and directed, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend
22 the funds, which are appropriated for said purposes, by entering into contracts or agreements

1 pursuant to the Grant Award, in a manner that is consistent with the provisions of the Grant
2 Award Agreement.

3 **SECTION THREE.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate
4 preservation of public peace, public health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate
5 measure within the meaning of Section 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St.
6 Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and
7 approval by the Mayor.
