

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 45 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN PHYLLIS YOUNG**

3 An ordinance pertaining to street performers; repealing Section Four of Ordinance
4 64105, which is codified as Section 20.55.030 of the Revised Code of the City of St.
5 Louis, and establishing conditions by which street performers are issued permits, and
6 containing an emergency clause.

7 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

8 **SECTION ONE.** Section Four of Ordinance 64105, which is codified as Section
9 20.55.030 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, is hereby repealed and enacted in
10 lieu thereof is the following:

11 **SECTION FOUR. Permit--Conditions.**

12 (a) A permit shall be issued by the Director of Streets to each applicant therefor
13 in exchange for a completed application and a fee of \$100.00.

14 (b) A completed application for a permit shall contain the applicant's name,
15 address, telephone number and type of performance and shall be signed by the applicant.

16 (c) A permit may be valid from the date on which it is issued through
17 December 31st of the year in which it is issued.

18 (d) The permit shall be numbered and contain the name of the applicant and the
19 year in which it is issued.

20 (e) A permit shall be nontransferable.

21 (f) Upon issuing a permit, the Director of Streets shall also issue to the
22 performer a printed copy of this ordinance and a copy of any other ordinance, map or
23 information pertaining to the existing prohibitions and regulations of performers within
24 the city.

25 **SECTION TWO. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.**
