

**BOARD BILL NO. 50 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY**

1 An Ordinance, recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of  
2 Estimate and Apportionment authorizing a supplemental appropriation and set apart in the total  
3 amount of Two Million Three Hundred Twenty-three Thousand Dollars (\$2,323,000) from the  
4 Airport Development Fund established under Ordinance 59286 approved October 26, 1984, to the  
5 “Annual Budget” established under authority of Ordinance No. 68643 approved June 25, 2010 for  
6 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2011, for current expenses of the  
7 government as detailed in **EXHIBIT "1"** which is attached hereto and incorporated herein; and  
8 containing an emergency clause.

9 **WHEREAS**, the “Annual Budget” was established under authority of Ordinance No. 68643  
10 approved on June 25, 2010;

11 **WHEREAS**, the Charter of The City of St. Louis (the "City"), Article XVI, Section 6,  
12 authorizes supplemental appropriations when any accruing, unappropriated City revenue is available  
13 and when the Board of Estimate and Apportionment recommends same;

14 **WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to authorize a supplemental appropriation to the Annual  
15 Budget established under authority of Ordinance No. 68643 approved June 25, 2010 in the total  
16 amount of Two Million Three Hundred Twenty-three Thousand Dollars (\$2,323,000) for current  
17 expenses of the government as detailed in **EXHIBIT "1"** which is attached hereto and incorporated  
18 herein;

19 **WHEREAS**, there is a balance in excess of Two Million Three Hundred Twenty-three  
20 Thousand Dollars (\$2,323,000) available for appropriation from the Airport Development Fund  
21 established under Ordinance No. 59286 approved October 26, 1984, Exhibit A, Article V, Sections

2           **WHEREAS**, this Ordinance is recommended by the Airport Commission and the Board of  
3 Estimate and Apportionment.

4           **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

5           **SECTION ONE.** There is hereby authorized a supplemental appropriation and set apart in  
6 the total amount of Two Million Three Hundred Twenty-three Thousand Dollars (\$2,323,000) from  
7 the Airport Development Fund established under Ordinance 59286 approved October 26, 1984,  
8 Exhibit A, Article V, Sections 502 and 510, to the "Annual Budget" established under authority of  
9 Ordinance No. 68643 approved June 25, 2010 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010 and ending  
10 June 30, 2011, for current expenses of the government as detailed in **EXHIBIT "1"** which is  
11 attached hereto and incorporated herein.

12           **SECTION TWO.** In addition to the charter powers granted to the Comptroller to preserve  
13 the credit of the City of St. Louis (the "City"), and for that purpose, or in case of any extraordinary  
14 emergency of any kind, with the approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, and with or  
15 without any ordinance or other authority or appropriations therefore, to draw warrants on the  
16 treasurer or effect temporary loans to pay debts and judgments and other liabilities of the City, or to  
17 meet any such emergency, charging such warrants to any excess balances in appropriations made by  
18 this budget ordinance and then specifically reporting such action to the Board of Aldermen at its first  
19 meeting thereafter, the Comptroller is hereby directed to cause to be made transfers:

20           a. within departments, divisions of funds, if such transfers are under \$250,000 per  
21 occurrence and if they are approved by a majority vote of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment,

1           b.   between or among departments, divisions or funds (except Fund 1217-Capital  
2 Improvement Projects), if such funds are under \$250,000 per occurrence and if they are approved by  
3 a vote of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment.

4           **SECTION THREE.**   This Ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate  
5 preservation of the public peace, health or safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure  
6 pursuant to Article IV, Section 20, of the City Charter and shall become effective immediately upon  
7 passage and approval by the City's Mayor.
