

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 88 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN SHANE COHN**

2 An ordinance pertaining to the collection of funds to assist in the City's efforts to
3 support the restoration of St. Louis City Hall; authorizing the Comptroller to establish
4 "The City Hall Restoration Fund" to help provide needed repairs and restoration to the St.
5 Louis City Hall, located at 1200 Market; directing the Collector of Revenue to transfer to
6 the Comptroller any amount of money in excess of the amount due on any water bill,
7 personal property or real estate tax bill in the City of St. Louis which is designated by any
8 person, firm or corporation for the " The City Hall Restoration Fund " program; the
9 depositing of " The City Hall Restoration Fund " funds; and the use of " The City Hall
10 Restoration Fund " funds.

11 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

12 **SECTION ONE.** The City Hall Restoration Fund established

13 The Comptroller is authorized and directed to establish a fund to be designated as
14 "The City Hall Restoration Fund" to help provide needed repairs and restoration to the St.
15 Louis City Hall, located at 1200 Market. All interest earned by the funds deposited in
16 such special account shall be retained in the account to be appropriated according to
17 provisions of this ordinance. All expenditures from such fund shall be appropriated in
18 accordance with applicable law.

19 **SECTION TWO.** Excess payment disposition.

20 When any person, firm or corporation participating in "The City Hall Restoration
21 Fund " program pays an amount in excess of the amount due on any water bill, personal
22 property or real estate tax bill the Collector of Revenue shall remit to the Comptroller the
23 excess amount on a monthly basis.

1 **SECTION THREE.** Deposit in The City Hall Restoration Fund.

2 The Comptroller, upon receipt of such excess payments designated for the “The
3 City Hall Restoration Fund” program remitted by the collector, shall place said receipted
4 payments in the “The City Hall Restoration Fund” established in Section One.

5 **SECTION FOUR.** Use of funds.

6 Funds maintained in "The City Hall Restoration Fund" account shall only be used
7 for purposes relating to the mission of The City Hall Restoration Fund

8 The Mayor’s Office shall provide annually to all members of the Board of
9 Aldermen a report detailing the use of funds provided by the "The City Hall Restoration
10 Fund."

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
