

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 91 INTRODUCED BY PRESIDENT LEWIS REED AND**
2 **ALDERMAN TERRY KENNEDY**

3 An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, authorizing a
4 supplemental appropriation; amending Ordinance 69154, commonly referred to as the City of St.
5 Louis Annual Operating Plan for Fiscal Year 2012-2013; appropriating and setting apart
6 projected excess general fund revenues to address certain expenditures in the General Fund for
7 the current fiscal year, in the amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) as hereinafter
8 detailed; and containing an emergency clause.

9 **WITNESSETH THAT,**

10 WHEREAS, the City Budget Division has estimated general fund revenue accruing in
11 excess of \$2,000,000 over originally budgeted amounts in the current fiscal year, and;

12 WHEREAS, this amount has been anticipated and is being appropriated and set aside
13 in the current fiscal year to offset an increase in general fund debt service requirements for
14 the City’s convention center and avoid additional budget or service reductions in balancing
15 the budget for the coming fiscal year;

16 WHEREAS, the Charter of The City of St. Louis, Article XVI, Section 6, authorizes
17 supplemental appropriations when any accruing, unappropriated City revenue is available and
18 whenever an appropriation exceeds the amount required for the purpose for which it has been
19 made and when the Board of Estimate and Apportionment recommends same;

20 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

21 **SECTION ONE.**

22 Pursuant to the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, there is
23 hereby appropriated a supplemental appropriation, amending Ordinance 69154 in the amount of

1 Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from excess municipal revenues accruing to the general fund
2 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, for payment to Fund 1218 Trustee Lease Fund to be
3 utilized for a portion of debt service costs of the City's convention center during the next fiscal
4 year.

5 **SECTION TWO.**

6 Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance providing for the preservation of public
7 health and safety and providing for current expenses of the City government, it is hereby
8 declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of
9 the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective
10 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
