

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 9 INTRODUCED BY: ALDERMAN JOSEPH D. RODDY**

2
3 An ordinance pertaining to parking within "The Laclede-Forest Park-Newstead Parking District";
4 authorizing the Traffic Administrator to designate the location and restrictions for curb parking
5 of restricted parking zones within the Laclede-Forest Park-Newstead Parking District;
6 authorizing the placement of Permit Parking Only signs within the District; and prohibiting the
7 parking, within the District, of any vehicle which does not display the authorized permit;
8 containing definitions, a penalty clause and an emergency clause.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

11 SECTION ONE. Definitions.

12 A. "The Laclede-Forest Park-Newstead Parking District" is the area defined by the
13 following boundaries:

14 Starting from the northwestern point of Parcel #3905000090 (4368 Laclede Ave.), traveling east
15 along the south curblineline of the 4300 block of Laclede Avenue and ending at the intersection of
16 Laclede and Boyle;

17 And

18 Starting from the southwestern point of Parcel #3906008570 (4375 Laclede Ave.), traveling east
19 along the north curblineline of Laclede Avenue and ending at the intersection of Laclede and Boyle;

20 And

21 Starting from the southwestern point of Parcel #3905000415 (4371 Forest Park Ave.), traveling
22 east along the north curblineline of Forest Park Avenue and ending at the southeastern point of
23 Parcel #3905000280 (4311 Forest Park Ave.);

24 And

1 Starting from the southeastern point of Parcel #3901000190 (25 N. Newstead Ave.), traveling
2 north along the west curblineline of N. Newstead Avenue and ending at the intersection of Newstead
3 and West Pine;

4 B. "Parking permit" is a valid parking permit issued for the Laclede-Forest Park-
5 Newstead Parking District by the Traffic and Transportation Administrator of the City of St.
6 Louis.

7 C. "Resident" is a person who lives in property abutting a street designated in whole or in
8 part as a restricted parking zone.

9 D. "Restricted parking zone" is any street, or any portion of a street, within the
10 boundaries of the Laclede-Forest Park-Newstead Parking District which is designated and posted
11 by the Traffic and Transportation Administrator as a restricted parking zone with specific
12 parking restrictions.

13 E. "Visitor" is any person who is a household guest, a visitor, a worker performing
14 services for, or domestic help for, a resident.

15 F. "Employee" is any person who is employed at a business abutting a street designated
16 in whole or in part as a restricted parking zone.

17 Section Two. Designation of restricted parking zones.

18 The Traffic and Transportation Administrator is hereby authorized to designate the
19 location and restrictions for curb parking of restricted parking zones within the Laclede-Forest
20 Park-Newstead Parking District on any street, or any portion of a street, on which the
21 predominant land used is zoned A or B, when 65 percent of the registered voters living on said
22 street indicate by petition that they desire a street, or a portion of a street, to be made a restricted

1 parking zone and when the Alderman from the ward, wherein the street is located, indicate that
2 such alderman recommends the designation.

3 Section Three. Permit use.

4 A. When signs are erected upon streets in restricted parking zones designating "Permit
5 Parking Only" during certain hours of the day on certain days, no person, firm or corporation
6 shall park or cause to be parked any vehicle during such hours of such days that does not display
7 a valid parking permit.

8 B. When signs are erected upon streets in parking zones restricting public curb parking to
9 certain amounts of time during certain hours of the day on certain days, no person, firm or
10 corporation shall park or cause to be parked in excess of the prescribed parking time limit any
11 vehicle that does not display either a resident or visitor parking permit.

12 Section Four. Permit issuance.

13 The Traffic and Transportation Administrator may issue annual parking permits to the
14 residents of any designated parking zone. The Traffic and Transportation Administrator may
15 contract with a Missouri nonprofit corporation at no cost to the City for the procurement,
16 assignment and distribution of said annual parking permits, and the procurement and installation
17 of said signs.

18 Section Five. Penalty for violation.

19 A. Any person, firm or corporation who shall park or cause to be parked any vehicle in
20 violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon the conviction thereof be fined twenty
21 dollars (\$20.00) for each such offense.

22 B. Any person, firm or corporation who shall distribute a resident or visitor parking
23 permit to any person, firm or corporation not authorized to display such parking permit shall

1 have his or her parking permits suspended by the Traffic and Transportation Administrator for a
2 period not to exceed one year.

4 Section Six. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

5 This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is
6 hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article
7 IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore shall become effective immediately upon
8 its passage and approval by the mayor.
